Our Righteousness

~The Passage: Jeremiah 33:3-8, 14-16~

As a kid what made you say “That’s not fair!”?

Jeremiah 33:3-5 (NKJV)

- ³ 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'
- ⁴ "For thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, concerning the houses of this city and the houses of the kings of Judah, which have been pulled down *to fortify* against the siege mounds and the sword:
- ⁵ "They come to fight with the Chaldeans, but *only* to fill their places with the dead bodies of men whom I will slay in My anger and My fury, all for whose wickedness I have hidden My face from this city.

What captures your attention about God’s character in these verses?

Jeremiah 33:6-8 (NKJV)

- ⁶ Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.
- ⁷ And I will cause the captives of Judah and the captives of Israel to return, and will rebuild those places as at the first.
- ⁸ I will cleanse them from all their iniquity by which they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities by which they have sinned and by which they have transgressed against Me.

How have you experienced God’s health and cleansing?

Jeremiah 33:14-16 (NKJV)

- ¹⁴ 'Behold, the days are coming,' says the LORD, 'that I will perform that good thing which I have promised to the house of Israel and to the house of Judah:
- ¹⁵ 'In those days and at that time I will cause to grow up to David A Branch of righteousness; He shall execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.
- ¹⁶ In those days Judah will be saved, And Jerusalem will dwell safely. And this *is the name* by which she will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.'

How can our actions and attitudes demonstrate that we serve God as our righteousness?
