When have you seen a fix-it job actually make things worse?

Deuteronomy 5:32-33 (NKJV)

³²“Therefore you shall ^[a]be careful to do as the LORD your God has commanded you; you shall not turn aside to the right hand or to the left. ³³You shall walk in all the ways which the LORD your God has commanded you, that you may live and *that it may be* well with you, and *that* you may prolong *your* days in the land which you shall possess.

How have you experienced the blessings that come from following God's instruction?

Galatians 3:10-12 New King James Version (NKJV)

¹⁰For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, “Cursed *is* everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them.” ¹¹But that no one is ^[a]justified by the law in the sight of God *is* evident, for “the just shall live by faith.” ¹²Yet the law is not of faith, but “the man who does them shall live by them.”

What is the difference between living by the law and living by faith?

Galatians 3:19, 24-25 (NKJV)

¹⁹What purpose then *does* the law *serve*? It was added because of transgressions, till the Seed should come to whom the promise was made; *and it was* appointed through angels by the hand of a mediator.

²⁴Therefore the law was our ^[a]tutor *to bring us* to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
²⁵But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor. mediator.
